

Weed-N-Feed Fertilizer with Surge Broadleaf Herbicide NPK 16-0-9

1. Apply in spring and fall is recommended for the best control. However this product can be applied any time broadleaf weeds are present and actively growing. No more than two times a year and 30 days apart.
2. Mow the turf grass 1 to 2 days before application.
3. Water the turf grass thoroughly ($\frac{1}{2}$ ") at least 1 to 2 days before application.
4. Apply in the morning when dew is present. Or, sprinkle or irrigate lightly ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") before application to provide maximum control.
5. Do not irrigate the turf grass within 24 hours after application. Rainfall or irrigation within 24 hours after application may reduce the effectiveness.
6. Do not apply this product to newly seeded lawns. Apply only on established lawns that have been mowed at least 3 times.
7. Wait at least 5 days to 1 week before the next mowing.
8. Stay off the turf grass at least for 24 hours.
9. Do not allow pets or people to enter the treated area until after the dust has settled.
10. Use when air temperature is warm during the day and the nights are not cold. Do not use in extreme heat or in the winter time, when plants are dormant.
11. Apply on a calm day with very little or no wind.
12. Do not use "up wind" of people or vegetables or other broad leaf plants. Surge does give off a gas that can drift a short distance and harm other plants nearby.
13. Follow directions on bag for spreader settings.

Application Ratio:

1 lb per 250 sq ft. 3 to 4 lbs per 1,000 sq ft of turf grass. 40 lb bag will cover 16,000 sq ft of turf grass

Surge is a broad leaf killer. Can be hazardous to humans and animals. Can cause moderate eye irritations. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Do not breathe. For protection, use gloves, long sleeves shirts, long pants, socks & shoes.
